

What are Emollients?

Emollients are moisturisers which are used to help dry or itchy skin

They are usually applied often, and in generous amounts



Fire Risks with Emollients



Emollients can transfer from skin onto materials such as clothing or bedding



When exposed to a naked flame, emollients are more likely to catch fire

To avoid this increased fire risk, always:



Keep away from fire and lit cigarettes



Wash clothing and bedding at a high temperature regularly to remove any dried emollient



Reducing the Risk of Slips

Emollients can be very slippery. To avoid injury, ensure you:



Use a non-slip mat in the bath or shower



Clean the bath/ shower after use
